All,

We are continuing to monitor and adapt to the spread of the COVID-19 virus throughout our city, state and country. Ashland Comfort Control is committed to taking all precautions necessary to prevent the infection of our customers, co-workers and their families while continuing to provide essential services. Below is a list of the minimum safety precautions we expect each of our employees to follow at all times:

<u>Initial</u>	Safety Precaution
	All office and field personnel shall measure and record their body temperature each work day using their own or a company provided thermometer.
	All office and field personnel shall notify their direct supervisor and refrain from coming to work (or should leave work) if they or someone they live with become sick, have a fever, or begin to display any of the symptoms associated with the virus.
	Office and field personnel shall ask <u>all</u> customers prior to entering their home or place of work whether any occupants are sick, have a fever, or are displaying any of the symptoms associate with the virus. If the answer is anything other than negative, the employee shall consult their immediate supervisor prior to entering the premises.
	At all times physically possible, personnel shall maintain six feet of separation between themselves and any customer, vendor, other contractor or co-worker.
	Personnel shall make all attempts to cover coughs and sneezes with their elbow and refrain fro touching their face.
	All personnel shall regularly wash their hands with soap and warm water for 20 seconds. Use hand sanitizer as available and necessary.
	Field and office personnel are encouraged to wear a mask or respirator of their choice when working indoors and available. Masks are available from ACC, however an employee may choose to provide their own.
	Field and office personnel are encouraged to wear gloves when available, particularly when working with and/or touching surfaces that may be frequently touched by others (door knobs, hand rails, gas pumps, ATM/Credt Card terminals, thermostats, toilet flush handles, etc).
